



# Word definitions - wordscapes level 1092

LUMP - Something that protrudes, sticks out, or sticks together; a cluster or blob; a mound, hill, or group.

MELT - Molten material, the product of melting.

MULE - A generally sterile male or female hybrid offspring of a male donkey and a female horse.

MUTE - To silence, to make quiet.

PLUM - The edible, fleshy stone fruit of *Prunus domestica*, often of a dark red or purple colour.

PELT - The skin of a beast with the hair on; a raw or undressed hide; a skin preserved with the hairy or woolly covering on it.

TEMP - A temporary employee, usually in an office.

PLUME - A feather of a bird, especially a large or showy one.

PUMMEL - To hit or strike heavily and repeatedly.

PLUMMET - To drop swiftly, in a direct manner; to fall quickly.
