LIE - To be in a horizontal position.

LIP - Either of the two fleshy protrusions around the opening of the mouth.

PIE - A type of pastry that consists of an outer crust and a filling.

PIER - A raised platform built from the shore out over water, supported on piles; used to secure, or provide access to shipping; a jetty.

PILE - A dart; an arrow.

PIPE - A rigid tube that transports water, steam, or other fluid, as used in plumbing and numerous other applications.

PREP - Preparation.

RIPE - Ready for reaping or gathering; having attained perfection; mature; -- said of fruits, seeds, etc.; as, ripe grain.

PERIL - A situation of serious and immediate danger.

RIPPLE - A moving disturbance or undulation in the surface of a liquid.
