Word definitions - wordscapes level 1192

HAIL - Balls or pieces of ice falling as precipitation, often in connection with a thunderstorm.

HISS - A high-pitched sound made by a snake, cat, escaping steam, etc.

SAIL - A piece of fabric attached to a boat and arranged such that it causes the wind to drive the boat along. The sail may be attached to the boat via a combination of mast, spars and ropes.

VISA - A permit to enter and leave a country, normally issued by the authorities of the country to be visited.

AILS - Plural form of ail.

VIAL - A glass vessel or bottle, especially a small bottle used to store medicine or perfume.

LASH - The thong or braided cord of a whip, with which the blow is given.

LASS - A young woman or girl.

SASH - A decorative length of cloth worn as a broad belt or over the shoulder, often for ceremonial or other formal occasions.

SLASH - A swift cut with a blade, particularly with fighting weapons as a sword, sabre, knife etc.

SISAL - A Central American plant, of the genus Agave, cultivated for its sword-shaped leaves that yield fibers used for rope.

LAVISH - Expending or bestowing profusely; profuse; prodigal; as, lavish of money; lavish of praise.

SLAVISH - In the manner of a slave; abject.
