This puzzle 31 extra words make it fun to play.

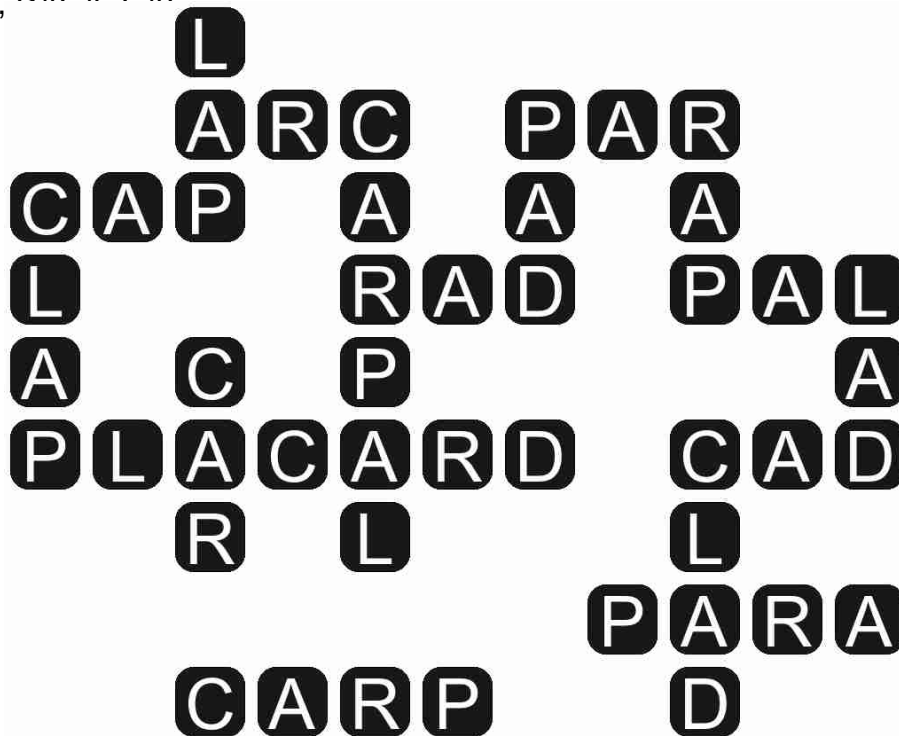
Reaching this point shows that you completed 15,008 words and 61,341 letters.

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# Word definitions - wordscapes level 1322

ARC - A directed edge.

CAP - A close-fitting head covering either without a brim or with a peak.

CAR - A wheeled vehicle, drawn by a horse or other animal.

LAD - A boy or young man.

LAP - The loose part of a coat; the lower part of a garment that plays loosely; a skirt; an apron.

PAD - A flattened mass of anything soft, to sit or lie on.

PAL - A friend, buddy, mate, cobbler, someone to hang around with.

PAR - By; with.

RAP - A sharp blow with something hard.

CAD - A person who stands at the door of an omnibus to open and shut it, and to receive fares; an idle hanger-on about inns.

RAD - Excellent, short for radical.

CLAD - To clothe.

CARP - Any of various freshwater fish of the family Cyprinidae, especially the common carp, *Cyprinus carpio*.

CLAP - The act of striking the palms of the hands, or any two surfaces, together.

PARA - Formerly, a subunit of currency in several countries in the Ottoman/Turkish and Yugoslav regions.

CARPAL - Any of the eight bones of the wrist (carpus).

PLACARD - A sheet of paper or cardboard with a written or printed announcement on one side for display in a public place.
