Word definitions - wordscapes level 1409

COW - A female domesticated ox or other bovine, especially an adult after she has had a calf.

ORE - Rock that contains utilitarian materials; primarily a rock containing metals or gems which (at the time of the rock's evaluation and proposal for extraction) are able to be separated from its neighboring minerals and processed at a cost that does not exceed those materials' present-day economic values.

OWE - To be under an obligation to give something back to someone or to perform some action for someone.

ROW - A line of objects, often regularly spaced, such as seats in a theatre, vegetable plants in a garden etc.

SEW - To use a needle to pass thread repeatedly through (pieces of fabric) in order to join them together.

SOW - A female pig.

WOE - Grief; sorrow; misery; heavy calamity.

CORE - The central part of fruit, containing the kernels or seeds.

CREW - A group of people (often staff) manning and operating a large facility or piece of equipment such as a factory, ship, boat, or airplane.

CROW - A bird, usually black, of the genus *Corvus*, having a strong conical beak, with projecting bristles; it has a harsh, croaking call.

ROSE - A shrub of the genus *Rosa*, with red, pink, white or yellow flowers.

SORE - Causing pain or discomfort; painfully sensitive.

WORE - Simple past of wear.

COWER - To crouch or cringe in fear.

SCORE - The total number of points earned by a participant in a game.

SCREW - A simple machine, a helical inclined plane.

SWORE - Simple past of swear.

WORSE - Comparative form of bad: more bad.

ESCROW - A written instrument, such as a deed, temporarily deposited with a neutral third party (the Escrow agent), by the agreement of two parties to a valid contract. The escrow agent will deliver the document to the benefited party when the conditions of the contract have been met. The depositor has no control over the instrument in escrow.
