This puzzle 51 extra words make it fun to play.


Reaching this point shows that you completed 16,926 words and 69,356 letters.

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 1488

RIM - An edge around something, especially when circular.

SEW - To use a needle to pass thread repeatedly through (pieces of fabric) in order to join them together.

SIM - A simulation.

SIR - A man of a higher rank or position.

IRE - Iron.

REM - Rapid eye movement, a sleep state.

RISE - The process of or an action or instance of moving upwards or becoming greater.

SWIM - To float.

WIRE - Metal formed into a thin, even thread, now usually by being drawn through a hole in a steel die.

WISE - Showing good judgement or the benefit of experience.

SIRE - A lord, master, or other person in authority, most commonly used vocatively.

MIME - A form of acting without words; pantomime.

MIRE - Deep mud; moist, spongy earth.

SEMI - A semi-detached house.

WISER - Comparative form of wise: more wise.

MISER - A person who hoards money rather than spending it; one who is cheap or extremely parsimonious.

SIMMER - The state or process of simmering.

SWIMMER - One who swims.
