This puzzle 20 extra words make it fun to play.

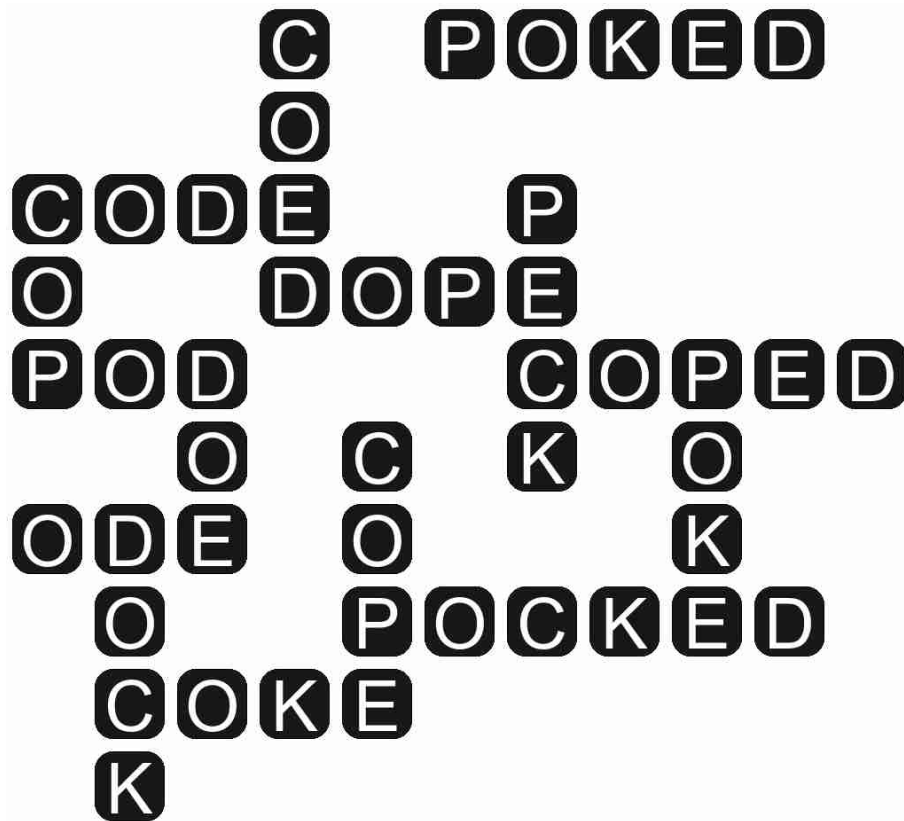
Reaching this point shows that you completed 17,209 words and 70,492 letters.

The words included in this word game are:

COP, POD, DOE, ODE, CODE, COKE, COPE, DOCK, DOPE, POKE, PECK, COED, COPED, POKED, POCKED.

The extra or bonus words are:

KEP, PEC, ECOD, COD, POCK, KOP, PED, DECK, CEP, DOP, DEP, COKED, DOEK, OKE, DOC, OPE, KED, DECO, OPED, ECO.



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Word definitions - wordscapes level 1509

COP - To (be forced to) take; to receive; to shoulder; to bear, especially blame or punishment for a particular instance of wrongdoing.

POD - A seed case for legumes (e.g. peas, beans, peppers).

DOE - A female deer; also used of similar animals such as reindeer, antelope, goat.

ODE - A short poetical composition proper to be set to music or sung; a lyric poem; especially, now, a poem characterized by sustained noble sentiment and appropriate dignity of style.

CODE - A short symbol, often with little relation to the item it represents.

COKE - Solid residue from roasting coal in a coke oven; used principally as a fuel and in the production of steel and formerly as a domestic fuel.

COPE - To deal effectively with something difficult.

DOCK - Any of the genus *Rumex* of coarse weedy plants with small green flowers related to buckwheat, especially the common dock, and used as potherbs and in folk medicine, especially in curing nettle rash.

DOPE - Any viscous liquid or paste, such as a lubricant, used in preparing a surface.

POKE - To poke a fire to remove ash or promote burning.

PECK - One quarter of a bushel; a dry measure of eight quarts.

COED - Alternative spelling of co-ed.

COPED - Simple past tense and past participle of cope.

POKED - Simple past tense and past participle of poke.

POCKED - Simple past tense and past participle of pock.
