This puzzle 13 extra words make it cool to play.


Reaching this point shows that you completed 17,686 words and 72,470 letters.

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 1549

ARM - The portion of the upper human appendage, from the shoulder to the wrist and so metimes including the hand.

MAR - To spoil, to damage.

OAR - An implement used to propel a boat or a ship in the water, having a flat blade at one end, being rowed from the other end and being normally fastened to the vessel.

RAM - A male sheep.

RAW - Of weather: unpleasantly damp or cold.

ROW - A line of objects, often regularly spaced, such as seats in a theatre, vegetable plants in a garden etc.

WAR - Organized, large-scale, armed conflict between countries or between national, ethnic, or other sizeable groups, usually involving the engagement of military forces.

MOW - To cut something (especially grass or crops) down or knock down.

MAW - The stomach, especially of an animal.

ROAM - To wander or travel freely and with no specific destination.

ROAR - To make a loud, deep cry, especially from pain, anger, or other strong emotion

WARM - Having a temperature slightly higher than usual, but still pleasant; a mild temperature.

WORM - A generally tubular invertebrate of the annelid phylum.

ARMOR - A protective layer over a body, vehicle, or other object intended to deflect or diffuse damaging forces.

ARROW - A projectile consisting of a shaft, a point and a tail with stabilizing fins that is shot from a bow.

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
