This puzzle 62 extra words make it fun to play.

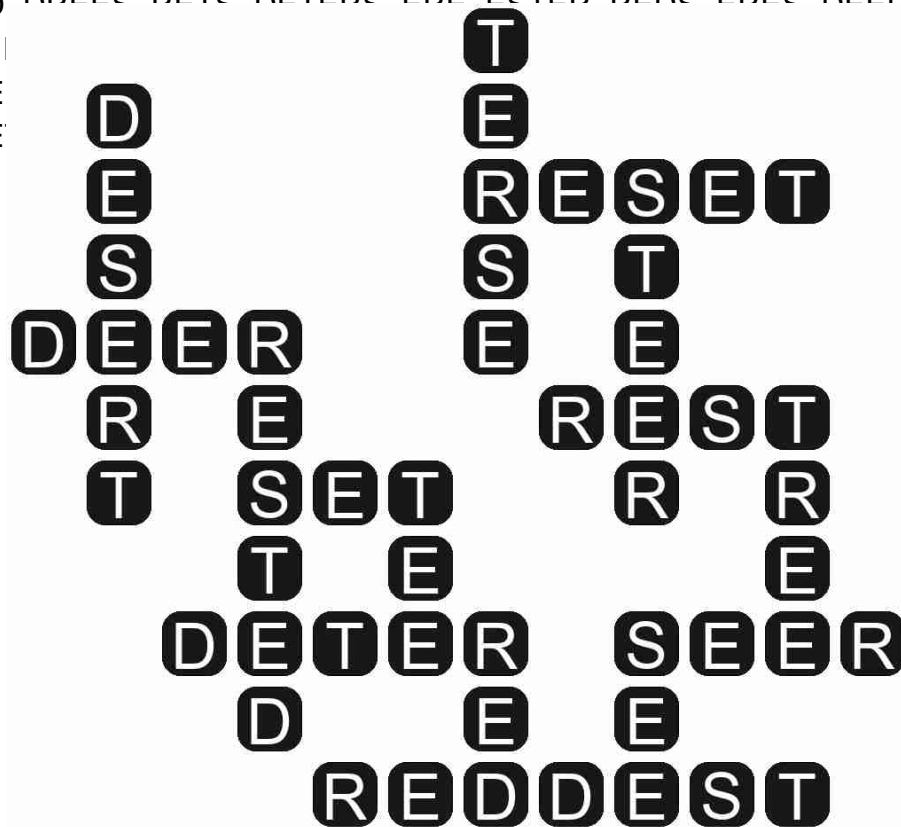
Reaching this point shows that you completed 18,910 words and 77,592 letters.

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 1656

RED - Having red as its colour.

SEE - To perceive or detect with the eyes, or as if by sight.

SET - To put (something) down, to rest.

TEE - The name of the Latin script letter T/t.

DEER - A beast, usually a quadruped as opposed to birds, fish, etc.

REST - Relief from work or activity by sleeping; sleep.

TREE - A large plant, not exactly defined, but typically over four meters in height, a single trunk which grows in girth with age and branches (which also grow in circumference with age).

SEER - Agent noun of see; one who sees something; an eyewitness.

DETER - To prevent something from happening.

STEER - The castrated male of cattle, especially one raised for beef production.

RESET - To set back to the initial state.

TERSE - Polished, burnished; smooth; fine, neat, spruce.

DESERT - That which is deserved or merited; a just punishment or reward.

RESTED - Recovered.

REDDEST - Superlative form of red: most red.
