This puzzle 40 extra words make it fun to play.

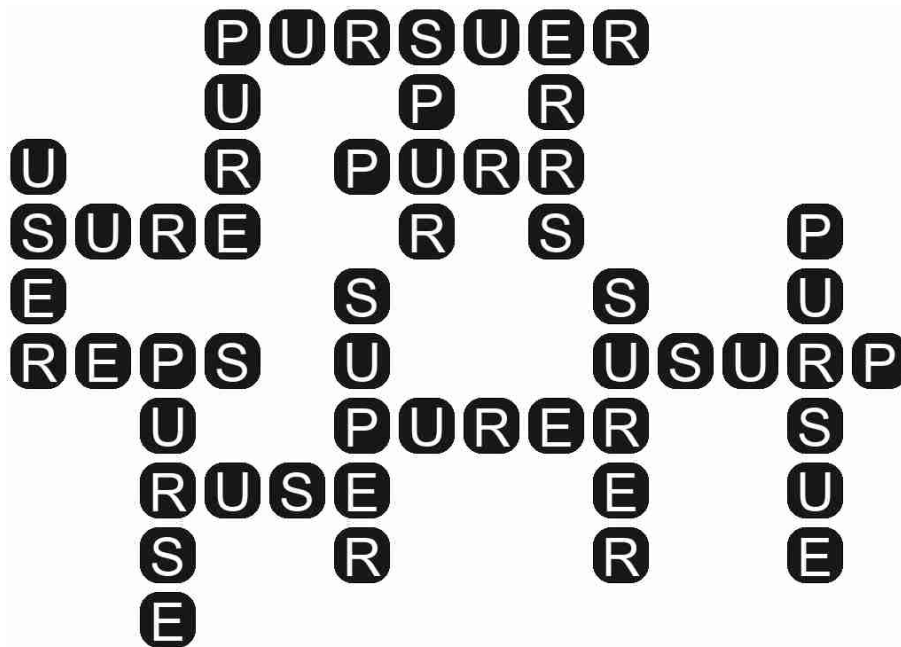
Reaching this point shows that you completed 19,095 words and 78,388 letters.

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 1672

PURE - Free of flaws or imperfections; unsullied.

SURE - Physically secure and certain, non-failing, reliable.

USER - One who uses or makes use of something, a consumer.

PURR - Of a cat, to make a vibrating sound in its throat when contented.

REPS - Rep.

SPUR - A rigid implement, often roughly y-shaped, that is fixed to one's heel for purpose of prodding a horse. Often worn by, and emblematic of, the cowboy or the knight.

RUSE - A trick.

ERRS - Third-person singular simple present indicative form of err.

PURSE - A small bag for carrying money.

SUPER - Of excellent quality, superfine.

PURER - Comparative form of pure: more pure.

SURER - Comparative form of sure: more sure.

USURP - To seize power from another, usually by illegitimate means.

PURSUE - To participate in (an activity, business etc.); to practise, follow (a profession).

PURSUER - One who pursues.
