This puzzle 24 extra words make it fun to play.

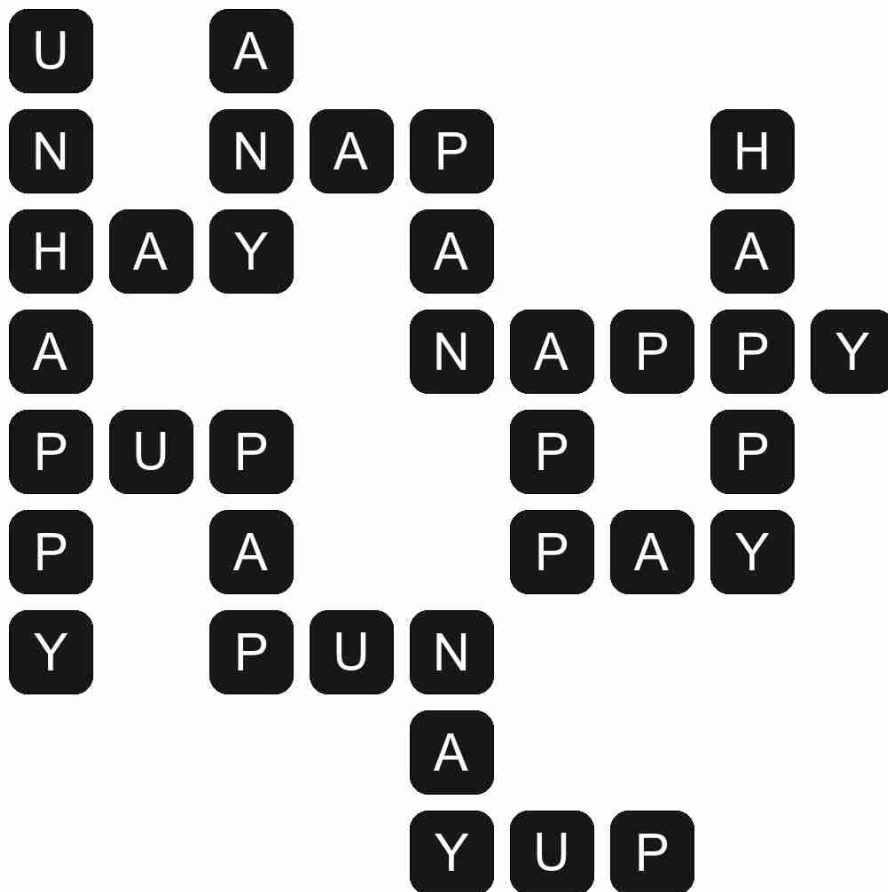
Reaching this point shows that you completed 20,530 words and 84,400 letters.

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# Word definitions - wordscapes level 1801

ANY - To even the slightest extent, at all.

APP - An application (program), especially a small one designed for a mobile device.

HAY - Grass cut and dried for use as animal fodder.

NAP - A short period of sleep, especially one during the day.

PAN - A wide, flat receptacle used around the house, especially for cooking.

PAY - To give money or other compensation to in exchange for goods or services.

PUP - A young dog, wolf, fox, seal, shark and some other animals.

YUP - A yes; an affirmative answer.

PAP - Food in the form of a soft paste, often a porridge, especially as given to very young children.

NAY - No.

PUN - To beat; strike with force; ram; pound, as in a mortar; reduce to powder.

HAPPY - Experiencing the effect of favourable fortune; having the feeling arising from the consciousness of well-being or of enjoyment; enjoying good of any kind, as peace, tranquillity, comfort; contented; joyous.

NAPPY - An absorbent garment worn by a baby who does not yet have voluntary control of his or her bladder and bowels or by someone who is incontinent.

UNHAPPY - Not happy; sad.
