ACTS - Plural form of act.

CASH - Money in the form of notes/bills and coins, as opposed to cheques/checks or electronic transactions.

CAST - To perform, bring forth (a magical spell or enchantment).

CATS - Plural form of cat.

CHAT - To be engaged in informal conversation.

HATS - Plural form of hat.

SWAT - To beat off, as insects; to bat, strike, or hit.

WASH - To clean with water.

WHAT - Which thing, event, circumstance, etc.: used interrogatively in asking for the specification of an identity, quantity, quality, etc.

THAW - To melt, dissolve, or become fluid (specifically by gradual warming); to soften; said of that which is frozen.

WATCH - A portable or wearable timepiece.

SWATH - The track cut out by a scythe in mowing.

SWATCH - A piece, pattern, or sample, generally of cloth or a similar material.
