This puzzle 60 extra words make it fun to play.

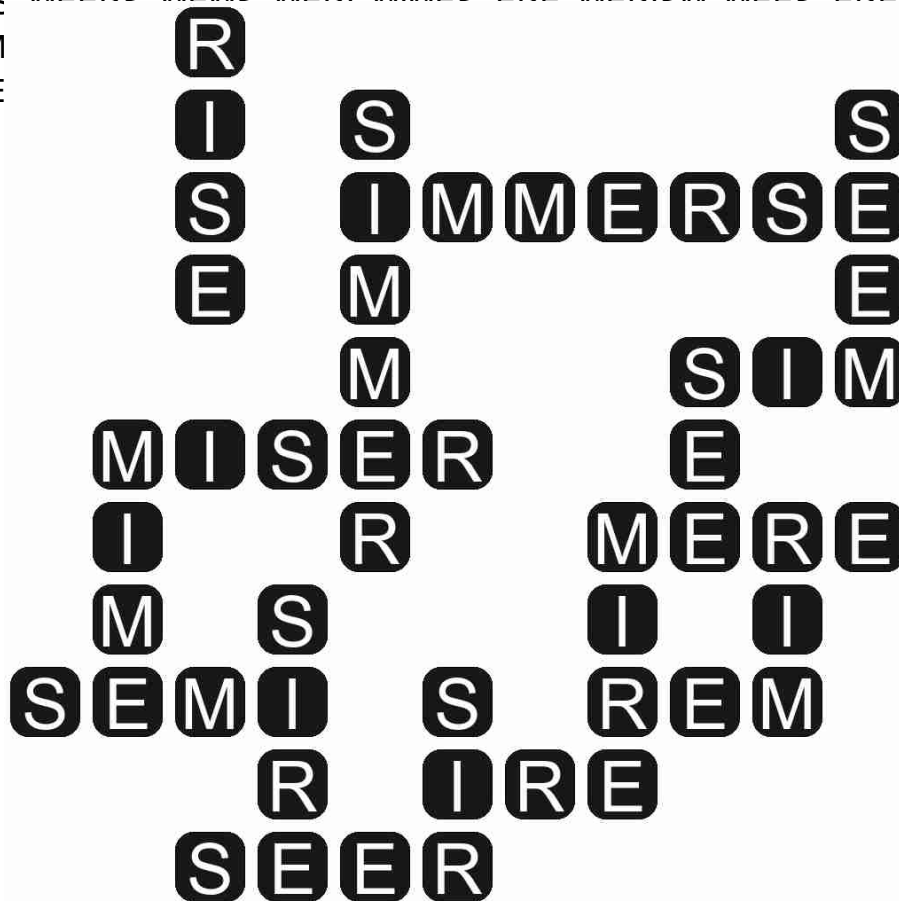
Reaching this point shows that you completed 20,564 words and 84,539 letters.

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 1804

RIM - An edge around something, especially when circular.

SEE - To perceive or detect with the eyes, or as if by sight.

SIM - A simulation.

SIR - A man of a higher rank or position.

IRE - Iron.

REM - Rapid eye movement, a sleep state.

MERE - The sea.

RISE - The process of or an action or instance of moving upwards or becoming greater.

SEEM - To appear; to look outwardly; to be perceived as.

SEER - Agent noun of see; one who sees something; an eyewitness.

SIRE - A lord, master, or other person in authority, most commonly used vocatively.

MIME - A form of acting without words; pantomime.

MIRE - Deep mud; moist, spongy earth.

SEMI - A semi-detached house.

MISER - A person who hoards money rather than spending it; one who is cheap or extremely parsimonious.

SIMMER - The state or process of simmering.

IMMERSE - To put under the surface of a liquid; to dunk.
