ILL - Extremely bad (bad enough to make one ill). Generally used indirectly with to be.

OIL - Liquid fat.

OLD - Of an object, concept, relationship, etc., having existed for a relatively long period of time.

SLY - Artfully cunning; secretly mischievous; wily.

SOD - That stratum of the surface of the soil which is filled with the roots of grass, or any portion of that surface; turf; sward.

SOY - A Chinese and Japanese liquid sauce for fish, made by subjecting boiled beans to long fermentation and then long digestion in salt and water. US preference is the term soy sauce.

DILL - *Anethum graveolens* (the sole species of the genus *Anethum*), is a herb, the seeds of which are moderately warming, pungent, and aromatic, and were formerly used as a soothing medicine for children; also known as dillseed.

DOLL - A toy in the form of a human.

IDOL - A graven image or representation of anything that is revered, or believed to convey spiritual power.

SLID - Simple past tense and past participle of slide.

SOIL - A mixture of sand and organic material, used to support plant growth.

IDLY - In an idle manner.

LILY - Any of several flowers in the genus *Lilium* of the family Liliaceae, which includes a great many ornamental species.

SILO - A vertical building, usually circular, used for the storage of grain.

SILL - A horizontal slat which forms the base of a window.

IDYLL - Any poem or short written piece composed in the style of Theocritus's short poems.
