This puzzle 60 extra words make it fun to play.


Reaching this point shows that you completed 24,935 words and 103,088 letters.

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# Word definitions - wordscapes level 2182

ARM - The portion of the upper human appendage, from the shoulder to the wrist and so metimes including the hand.

LAY - To place down in a position of rest, or in a horizontal position.

MAR - To spoil, to damage.

MAY - The hawthorn bush or its blossoms.

OAR - An implement used to propel a boat or a ship in the water, having a flat blade at one end, being rowed from the other end and being normally fastened to the vessel.

RAM - A male sheep.

RAY - A beam of light or radiation.

YAM - Any climbing vine of the genus Dioscorea in the Eastern and Western hemispheres , usually cultivated.

LAM - Used in the expression on the lam to mean that a person is fleeing law enforcement, possibly in hiding.

ORAL - A physical examination of the mouth.

ROAM - To wander or travel freely and with no specific destination.

LOAM - A kind of soil; an earthy mixture of clay and sand, with organic matter to which its fertility is chiefly due.

ALARM - A summons to arms, as on the approach of an enemy.

MAYOR - The leader of a city, or a municipality, sometimes just a figurehead and sometimes a powerful position. In some countries, the mayor is elected by the citizens or by the city council.

MORAL - Of or relating to principles of right and wrong in behaviour, especially for teaching right behaviour.

ROYAL - Of or relating to a monarch or their family.

AROMA - A smell; especially a pleasant spicy or fragrant one.

MOLAR - A back tooth having a broad surface used for grinding one's food.

AMORAL - Being neither moral nor immoral.

MAYORAL - Relating to the office of the mayor.
