OOPS - Acknowledging a minor mistake.

POEM - A literary piece written in verse.

POSE - Set in place, arrange.

SOME - A certain number, at least one.

COMP - A competition.

COOS - Third-person singular simple present indicative form of coo.

SPEC - Short form of specification.

SCOOP - Any cup- or bowl-shaped tool, usually including a handle used to lift and move loose or soft solid material.
