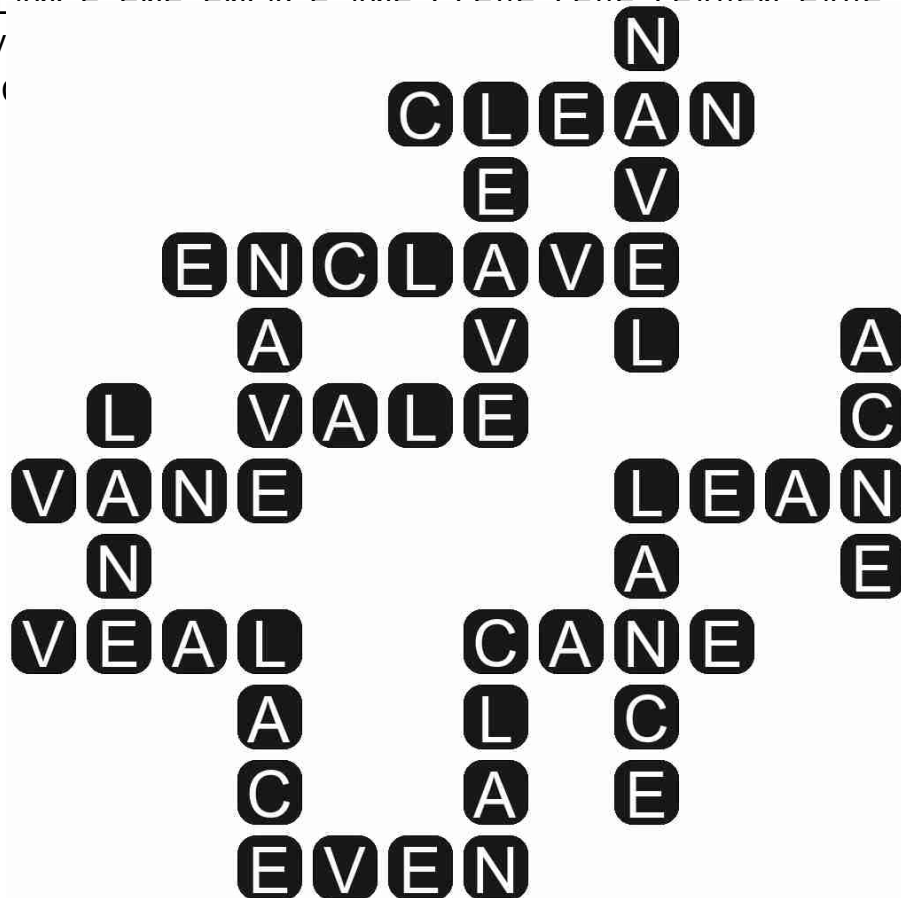

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 2220

ACNE - A skin condition, usually of the face, that is common in adolescents. It is characterised by red pimples, and is caused by the inflammation of sebaceous glands through bacterial infection.

CANE - The slender, flexible main stem of a plant such as bamboo, including many species in the Grass family Gramineae.

CLAN - A group of people all descended from a common ancestor, in fact or belief.

EVEN - Flat and level.

LACE - A light fabric containing patterns of holes, usually built up from a single thread.

LANE - A narrow passageway between fences, walls, hedges or trees.

LEAN - To hang outwards.

VEAL - The flesh of a calf used for food.

VANE - A weather vane.

NAVE - The middle or body of a church, extending from the transepts to the principal entrances.

VALE - Valley.

CLEAN - Not dirty.

LANCE - A weapon of war, consisting of a long shaft or handle and a steel blade or head; a spear carried by horsemen.

LEAVE - To cause or allow (something) to remain as available; to refrain from taking (something) away; to stop short of consuming or otherwise depleting (something) entirely.

NAVEL - The indentation or bump remaining in the abdomen of mammals where the umbilical cord was attached before birth.

ENCLAVE - A political, cultural or social entity or part thereof that is completely surrounded by another territory.

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
