This puzzle 53 extra words make it fun to play.

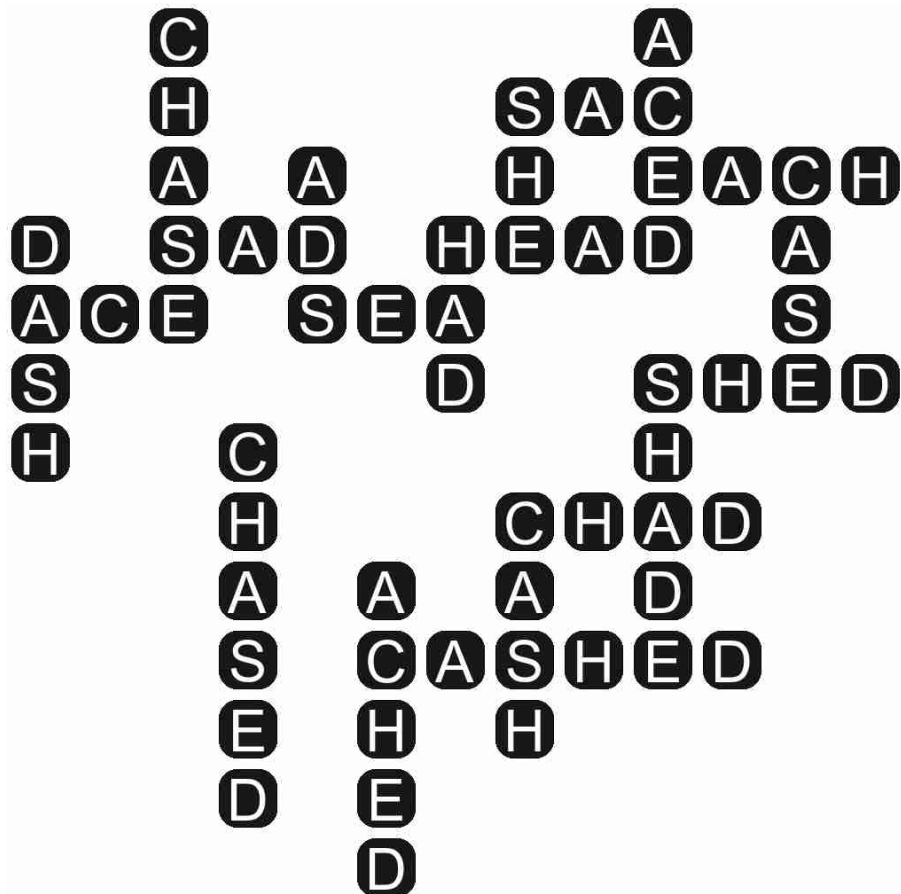
Reaching this point shows that you completed 26,997 words and 111,690 letters.

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 2358

ACE - A single point or spot on a playing card or die.

ADS - Plural form of ad.

HAD - Simple past tense and past participle of have.

SAD - Sated, having had one's fill; satisfied, weary.

SEA - A large body of salty water. (Major seas are known as oceans.).

SHE - A female person or animal.

SAC - A bag or pouch inside a plant or animal that typically contains a fluid.

CASE - An actual event, situation, or fact.

CASH - Money in the form of notes/bills and coins, as opposed to cheques/checks or electronic transactions.

DASH - A mark or line [- or ·], in writing or printing, denoting a sudden break, stop, or transition in a sentence, or an abrupt change in its construction, a long or significant pause, or an unexpected or epigrammatic turn of sentiment. Dashes are also sometimes used instead of marks or parenthesis.

EACH - All; every; qualifying a singular noun, indicating all examples of the things or named seen as individual or separate items (compare every).

HEAD - The part of the body of an animal or human which contains the brain, mouth, and main sense organs.

SHED - To part or divide.

ACED - Simple past tense and past participle of ace.

CHAD - Small pieces of paper punched out from the edges of continuous stationery, punched cards, paper tape etc.

CHASE - The action of the verb "to chase".

SHADE - Darkness where light, particularly sunlight, is blocked.
