This puzzle 29 extra words make it fun to play.


Reaching this point shows that you completed 2,370 words and 9,274 letters.

Word definitions - wordscapes level 246

ELM - A tree of the genus *Ulmus* of the family *Ulmaceae*, large deciduous trees with alternate stipulate leaves and small apetalous flowers.

LOB - To throw or hit a ball into the air in a high arch.

MOB - An unruly group of people.

OIL - Liquid fat.

BIO - A biography.

MIL - An angular mil, a unit of angular measurement equal to $1/6400$ of a complete circle. At 1000 metres one mil subtends about one metre (0.98 m). Also $1/6000$ and $1/6300$ are used in other countries.

LIMB - A major appendage of human or animal, used for locomotion (such as an arm, leg or wing).

LIME - A general term for inorganic materials containing calcium, usually calcium oxide or calcium hydroxide; quicklime.

LOBE - Any projection or division, especially one of a somewhat rounded form.

MILE - A Roman unit of measure equal to 1000 (double) steps (*mille passus* or *mille passuum*) or 5000 Roman feet (approx. 1480m).

LIMO - A limousine.

BILE - A bitter brownish-yellow or greenish-yellow secretion produced by the liver, stored in the gall bladder, and discharged into the duodenum where it aids the process of digestion.

LIMBO - The place where innocent souls exist temporarily until they can enter heaven, notably those of the saints who died before the advent of Christ (*limbus patrum*) and those of unbaptized but innocent children (*limbus infantum*).

MOBILE - Capable of being moved.
