LIE - To be in a horizontal position.

RIB - Any of a series of long curved bones occurring in 12 pairs in humans and other animals and extending from the spine to or toward the sternum.

RUB - An act of rubbing.

RUE - Repentance, regret.

ERR - To make a mistake.

IRE - Iron.

BLUE - Having a bluish colour shade.

BLUR - To make indistinct or hazy, to obscure or dim.

BURR - A sharp, pointy object, such as a sliver or splinter.

LURE - Something that tempts or attracts, especially one with a promise of reward or pleasure.

RULE - A regulation, law, guideline.

LUBE - Lubricant.

BILE - A bitter brownish-yellow or greenish-yellow secretion produced by the liver, stored in the gall bladder, and discharged into the duodenum where it aids the process of digestion.

BRIE - A variety of soft, mild French cheese made from cow's milk.

RULER - A (usually rigid), flat, rectangular measuring or drawing device with graduations in units of measurement; a rule; a straightedge with markings; a measure.

BLUER - Comparative form of blue: more blue.

BURLIER - Comparative form of burly: more burly.
