

Wordscapes level 2643 answers

Wordscapes level 2643 in the Lagoon Group and Palm Pack contains 19 words and the letters ABDET making it a relatively hard level.

This puzzle 14 extra words make it cool to play.

Reaching this point shows that you completed 30,378 words and 125,916 letters.

The words included in this word game are:

ATE, BAD, BAT, BED, BET, EAT, TAB, TAD, TEA, DAB, BEAT, BETA, DATA, DATE, DEBT, BEAD, BADE, ABATE, ABATED.

The extra or bonus words are:

TED, BAA, BAAED, ABA, DAE, ETA, TAED, DEB, TAE, BATE, ABED, BATED, ABET, TEAD.



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Word definitions - wordscapes level 2643

ATE - Simple past of eat.

BAD - Not good; unfavorable; negative.

BAT - Any of the small, nocturnal, flying mammals of the order Chiroptera, which navigate by means of echolocation. They look like a mouse with membranous wings extending from the forelimbs to the hind limbs or tail. Altogether, there are about 1,000 bat species in the world.

BED - A piece of furniture, usually flat and soft, to sleep on.

BET - A wager, an agreement between two parties that a stake (usually money) will be paid by the loser to the winner (the winner being the one who correctly forecast the outcome of an event).

EAT - To consume (something solid or semi-solid, usually food) by putting it into the mouth and swallowing it.

TAB - A small flap or strip of material attached to something, for holding, manipulation, identification, etc.

TAD - A small amount; a little bit.

TEA - The dried leaves or buds of the tea plant, *Camellia sinensis*.

DAB - To press lightly in a repetitive motion with a soft object without rubbing.

BEAT - A pulsation or throb.

BETA - Identifying a molecular position in an organic chemical compound.

DATA - Plural form of datum: pieces of information.

DATE - The fruit of the date palm. This sweet fruit is somewhat in the shape of an olive, containing a soft pulp and enclosing a hard kernel.

DEBT - An action, state of mind, or object one has an obligation to perform for another, adopt toward another, or give to another.

BEAD - A small round object.

ABATE - To cut away or hammer down, in such a way as to leave a figure in relief, as a sculpture, or in metalwork.

ABATED - Simple past tense and past participle of abate.
