ARCH - An inverted U shape.

CARE - Grief, sorrow.

EACH - All; every; qualifying a singular noun, indicating all examples of the thing s o named seen as individual or separate items (compare every).

HARE - Any of several plant-eating animals of the family Leporidae, especially of the genus Lepus, similar to a rabbit, but larger and with longer ears.

HEAR - To sympathize with; to share the feeling or opinion of.

RACE - A contest between people, animals, vehicles, etc. where the goal is to be the first to reach some objective. Several horses run in a horse race, and the first one to reach the finishing post wins.

RARE - Cooked very lightly, so the meat is still red (in the case of steak or beef in the general sense).

REAR - To raise physically; to lift up; to cause to rise, to elevate.

ACHE - To suffer pain; to be the source of, or be in, pain, especially continued dull pain; to be distressed.

ACRE - A field.

CHAR - A time; a turn or occasion.

CARER - Someone who looks after another, either as a job or often through family responsibilities.

RACER - Someone who takes part in a race.

REACH - To extend; to stretch; to thrust out; to put forth, as a limb, a member, some thing held, or the like.

ARCHER - One who shoots an arrow from a bow or a bolt from a crossbow.
