This puzzle 43 extra words make it fun to play.


Reaching this point shows that you completed 32,778 words and 135,871 letters.

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 2842

LED - Simple past tense and past participle of lead.

ODD - Single; sole; singular; not having a mate.

OLD - Of an object, concept, relationship, etc., having existed for a relatively long period of time.

ORE - Rock that contains utilitarian materials; primarily a rock containing metals or gems which (at the time of the rock's evaluation and proposal for extraction) are able to be separated from its neighboring minerals and processed at a cost that does not exceed those materials' present-day economic values.

RED - Having red as its colour.

ROD - A straight, round stick, shaft, bar, cane, or staff.

ODE - A short poetical composition proper to be set to music or sung; a lyric poem; especially, now, a poem characterized by sustained noble sentiment and appropriate dignity of style.

DOOR - A portal of entry into a building or room, consisting of a rigid plane movable on a hinge. Doors are frequently made of wood or metal. May have a handle to help open and close, a latch to hold the door closed, and a lock that ensures the door cannot be opened without the key.

LORD - The master of a household.

ROLE - A character or part played by a performer or actor.

LORE - All the facts and traditions about a particular subject that have been accumulated over time through education or experience.

REDO - To do again.

DOLE - To distribute in small amounts; to share out small portions of a meager resource.

ODDER - Comparative form of odd: more odd.

OLDER - Comparative form of old: more old, elder, senior.

RODEO - A North American sport involving skills with horses, cows and other livestock

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DROOL - To secrete saliva in anticipation of food.

DOLED - Simple past tense and past participle of dole.

DOODLE - A fool, a simpleton, a mindless person.
