This puzzle 97 extra words make it fun to play.

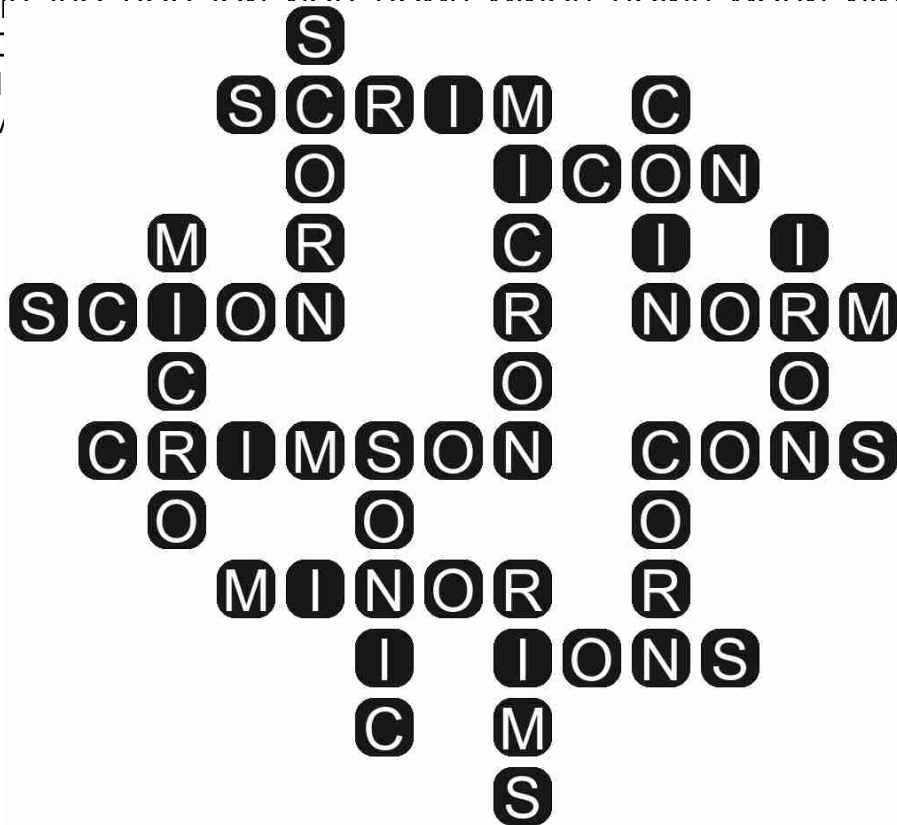
Reaching this point shows that you completed 33,033 words and 136,934 letters.

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# Word definitions - wordscapes level 2864

COIN - A piece of currency, usually metallic and in the shape of a disc, but sometimes polygonal, or with a hole in the middle.

CONS - Plural form of con.

CORN - A cereal plant grown for its grain, specifically the main such plant grown in a given region, such as oats in parts of Scotland and Ireland, wheat or barley in England and Wales, and maize or sweetcorn in the Americas.

ICON - An image, symbol, picture, or other representation usually as an object of religious devotion.

IONS - Plural form of ion.

IRON - A common, inexpensive metal, often black in color, that rusts, is attracted by magnets, and is used in making steel.

RIMS - Plural form of rim.

NORM - That which is regarded as normal or typical.

MINOR - Of little significance or importance.

SONIC - Of or relating to sound.

MICRO - Small, relatively small; used to contrast levels of the noun modified.

SCORN - To feel or display contempt or disdain for something or somebody; to despise.

SCION - A descendant, especially a first-generation descendant.

SCRIM - A kind of light cotton or linen fabric, often woven in openwork patterns, -- used for curtains, etc.,.

MICRON - A unit of length; the thousandth part of one millimeter; the millionth part of a meter.

CRIMSON - A deep, slightly bluish red.
