CLUE - A strand of yarn etc. as used to guide one through a labyrinth; something which points the way, a guide.

CURE - A method, device or medication that restores good health.

CURL - A piece or lock of curling hair; a ringlet.

LICK - To stroke with the tongue.

LIKE - To please.

LUCK - Something that happens to someone by chance, a chance occurrence.

LURE - Something that tempts or attracts, especially one with a promise of reward or pleasure.

RICE - Cereal plants (*Oryza sativa*) of the grass family whose seeds are used as food.

RULE - A regulation, law, guideline.

RILE - To make angry.

LICE - Plural form of louse.

LURK - To remain concealed in order to ambush.

CLERK - One who occupationally works with records, accounts, letters, etc.; an office worker.

RELIC - That which remains; that which is left after loss or decay; a remaining portion.

ULCER - An open sore of the skin, eyes or mucous membrane, often caused by an initial abrasion and generally maintained by an inflammation and/or an infection.

CRUEL - Not nice; mean; heartless.

LUCKIER - Comparative form of lucky: more lucky.
