ION - An atom or group of atoms bearing an electrical charge such as the sodium and chlorine atoms in a salt solution.

NOR - Used to introduce a further negative statement.

PIN - A small device, made (usually) of drawn-out steel wire with one end sharpened and the other flattened or rounded into a head, used for fastening.

PRO - An advantage of something, especially when contrasted with its disadvantages (cons).

RIP - A tear (in paper, etc.).

SIN - A violation of God's will or religious law.

SIP - A small mouthful of drink.

SIR - A man of a higher rank or position.

SON - A male child, a boy or man in relation to his parents; one's male offspring.

NIP - A small quantity of something edible or a potable liquor.

SOP - Something entirely soaked.

OPS - Plural form of op.

IRON - A common, inexpensive metal, often black in color, that rusts, is attracted by magnets, and is used in making steel.

SPIN - To rotate, revolve, gyrate (usually quickly); to partially or completely rotate to face another direction.

SNIP - To cut with short sharp actions, as with scissors.

PRISON - A place of long-term confinement for those convicted of serious crimes, or otherwise considered undesirable by the government.
