

Word definitions - wordscapes level 3030

PEAR - An edible fruit produced by the pear tree, similar to an apple but elongated towards the stem.

PEER - To look with difficulty, or as if searching for something.

PREP - Preparation.

RARE - Cooked very lightly, so the meat is still red (in the case of steak or beef in the general sense).

REAR - To raise physically; to lift up; to cause to rise, to elevate.

REAP - To cut with a sickle, scythe, or reaping machine, as grain; to gather, as a harvest, by cutting.

PARE - To remove the outer covering or skin of something with a cutting device, typically a knife.

PEEP - A quiet sound, particularly one from a baby bird.

PAPER - A sheet material used for writing on or printing on (or as a non-waterproof container), usually made by draining cellulose fibres from a suspension in water.

RAPPER - One who, or that which, raps or knocks; specifically, the knocker of a door.

REAPER - One who reaps.

PREPARE - To make ready for a specific future purpose; to set up; to assemble.
