This puzzle 40 extra words make it fun to play.


Reaching this point shows that you completed 35,677 words and 147,952 letters.

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 3083

AND - As a coordinating conjunction; expressing two elements to be taken together or in addition to each other.

ANT - Any of various insects in the family Formicidae in the order Hymenoptera, typically living in large colonies composed almost entirely of flightless females.

ATE - Simple past of eat.

EAT - To consume (something solid or semi-solid, usually food) by putting it into the mouth and swallowing it.

END - The final point of something in space or time.

TAD - A small amount; a little bit.

TEA - The dried leaves or buds of the tea plant, *Camellia sinensis*.

TEN - A numerical value equal to 10; the number occurring after nine and before eleven, represented in Roman numerals as X, in Arabic numerals as 10, and in the hexadecimal system (base 16) as A.

DATE - The fruit of the date palm. This sweet fruit is somewhat in the shape of an olive, containing a soft pulp and enclosing a hard kernel.

DEAN - A senior official in a college or university, who may be in charge of a division or faculty (for example, the dean of science) or have some other advisory or disciplinary function (for example, the dean of students).

DENT - A shallow deformation in the surface of an object, produced by an impact.

NEAT - A bull or cow.

TAKE - To grasp with the hands.

TANK - A container for liquids or gases.

TEND - To kindle; ignite; set on fire; light; inflame; burn.

DANK - (intransitive) To moisten, dampen; used of mist, dew etc.

TAKEN - Infatuated; fond of or attracted to.

KNEAD - To work and press into a mass, usually with the hands; especially, to work, a s by repeated pressure with the knuckles, into a well mixed mass, the materials of bread, cake, etc.

TANKED - Simple past tense and past participle of tank.
