ASH - The solid remains of a fire.

HAM - The region back of the knee joint; the popliteal space; the hock.

HAS - Third-person singular simple present indicative form of have.

HIM - A masculine pronoun; he as a grammatical object.

HIS - Belonging to him.

SIM - A simulation.

CAM - A turning or sliding piece which imparts motion to a rod, lever or block brought into sliding or rolling contact with it.

OHM - In the International System of Units, the derived unit of electrical resistance ; the electrical resistance of a device across which a potential difference of one volt causes a current of one ampere.

CASH - Money in the form of notes/bills and coins, as opposed to cheques/checks or electronic transactions.

COMA - A state of sleep from which one may not wake up, usually induced by some form of trauma.

SCAM - Fraudulent deal.

SHAM - Intended to deceive; false.

CAMO - A pattern on clothing consisting of irregularly shaped patches that are either greenish/brownish, brownish/whitish, or bluish/whitish, as used by ground combat forces.

MASH - A mesh.

MICA - Any of a group of hydrous aluminosilicate minerals characterized by highly perfect cleavage, so that they readily separate into very thin leaves, more or less elastic.

MACHO - Tending to display manly characteristics, such as domineering, fierceness, bravery.
