This puzzle 32 extra words make it fun to play.

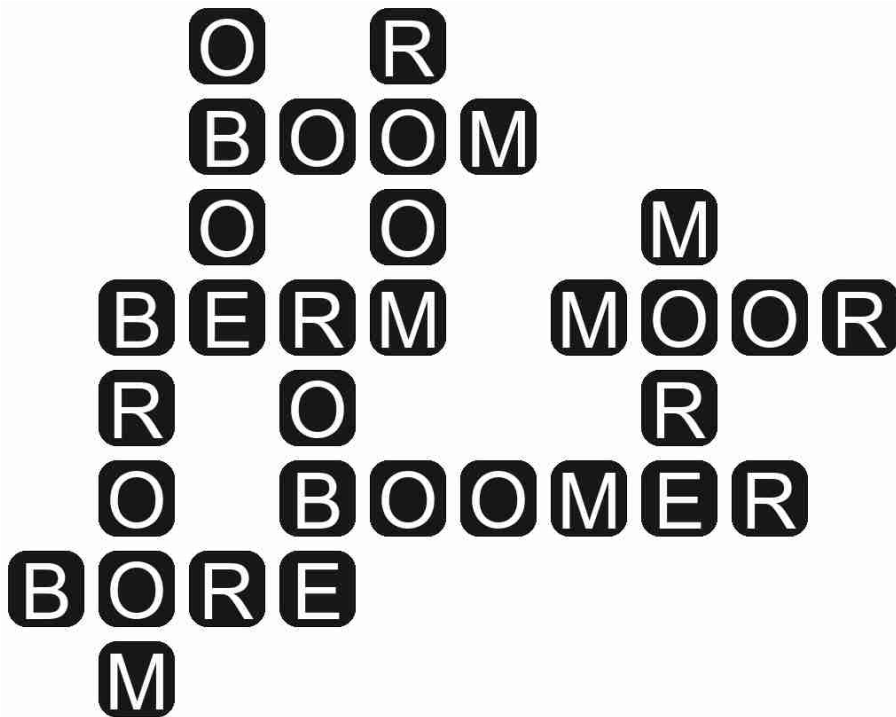
Reaching this point shows that you completed 39,293 words and 163,045 letters.

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 3387

BOOM - To make a loud, resonant sound.

BORE - To make a hole through something.

MORE - Comparative form of many: in greater number. (Used for a discrete quantity.).

ROBE - A long loose outer garment, often signifying honorary stature.

ROOM - Wide; spacious; roomy.

BERM - A narrow ledge or shelf, as along the top or bottom of a slope.

MOOR - An extensive waste covered with patches of heath, and having a poor, light soil, but sometimes marshy, and abounding in peat; a heath.

OBOE - A soprano and melody wind instrument in the modern orchestra and wind ensemble . It is a smaller instrument and generally made of grenadilla wood. It is a member of the double reed family.

BROOM - A domestic utensil with fibers bound together at the end of a long handle, used for sweeping.

BOOMER - An adult male kangaroo.
