This puzzle 67 extra words make it fun to play.


Reaching this point shows that you completed 39,730 words and 164,874 letters.

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 3424

HOT - Of an object, having a high temperature.

ROB - To steal from, especially using force or violence.

ROT - To suffer decomposition due to biological action, especially by fungi or bacteria.

COT - A symbol of the trigonometric function cotangent.

ORB - A spherical body; a globe; especially, one of the celestial spheres; a sun, planet, or star.

BOT - The larva of a bot fly, which infests the skin of various mammals, producing warbles, or the nasal passage of sheep, or the stomach of horses.

BRO - Brother; a male sibling.

COB - A male swan.

SOB - A cry with a short, sudden expulsion of breath.

BOTH - Each of the two; one and the other.

COST - Manner; way; means; available course; contrivance.

HOST - A person who allows a guest, particularly into the host's home.

SHOT - Worn out.

SORT - A general type.

BROTH - Water in which food (meat or vegetable etc) has been boiled.

SHORT - Having a small distance from one end or edge to another, either horizontally or vertically.

TORCH - A stick with a flame on one end, used chiefly as a light source; a similarly shaped implement with a replaceable supply of flammable material.

THROB - To pound or beat rapidly or violently.

BOTCH - To perform (a task) in an unacceptable or incompetent manner; to make a mess of something; to ruin; to bungle; to spoil; to destroy.

BORSCHT - A beetroot/beet soup that can be served hot or cold, usually with sour cream.
