This puzzle 29 extra words make it fun to play.

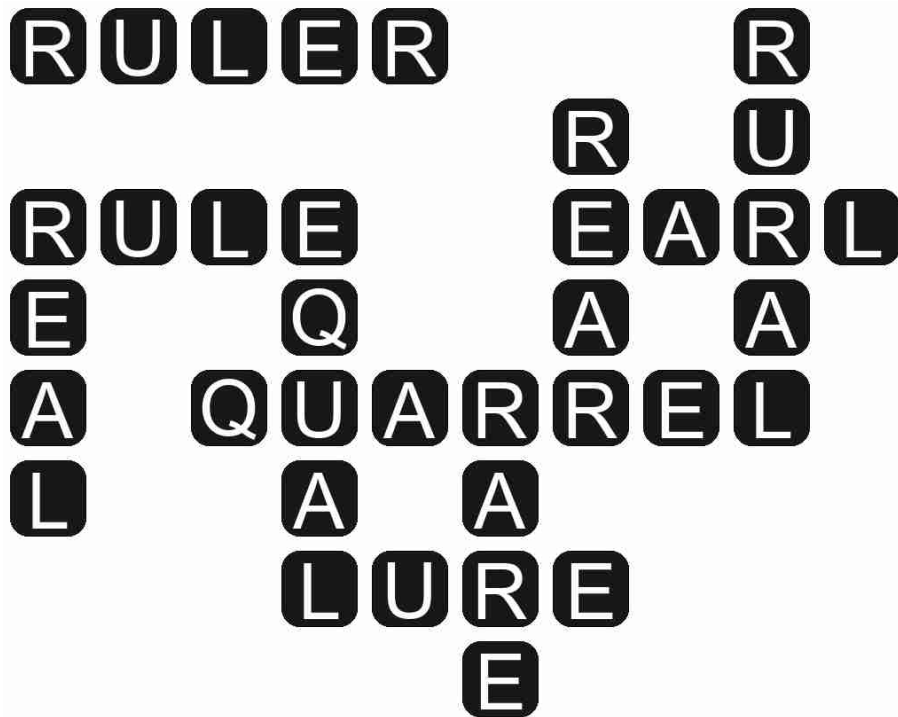
Reaching this point shows that you completed 41,864 words and 173,645 letters.

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 3606

EARL - A British nobleman next in rank above a viscount and below a marquess; equivalent to a European count. A female using the style is termed a countess.

LURE - Something that tempts or attracts, especially one with a promise of reward or pleasure.

RARE - Cooked very lightly, so the meat is still red (in the case of steak or beef in the general sense).

REAL - A commodity; see reality.

REAR - To raise physically; to lift up; to cause to rise, to elevate.

RULE - A regulation, law, guideline.

EQUAL - The same in all respects.

RULER - A (usually rigid), flat, rectangular measuring or drawing device with graduations in units of measurement; a rule; a straightedge with markings; a measure.

RURAL - Pertaining to less-populated, non-urban areas.

QUARREL - A verbal dispute or heated argument.
