CON - To study, especially in order to gain knowledge of.

NOR - Used to introduce a further negative statement.

ROD - A straight, round stick, shaft, bar, cane, or staff.

CORD - A long, thin, flexible length of twisted yarns (strands) of fiber.

CORN - A cereal plant grown for its grain, specifically the main such plant grown in a given region, such as oats in parts of Scotland and Ireland, wheat or barley in England and Wales, and maize or sweetcorn in the Americas.

DOOR - A portal of entry into a building or room, consisting of a rigid plane movable on a hinge. Doors are frequently made of wood or metal. May have a handle to help open and close, a latch to hold the door closed, and a lock that ensures the door cannot be opened without the key.

ODOR - Any smell, whether fragrant or offensive; scent; perfume.

COCO - Coconut palm.

CROC - A crocodile.

CONDO - A condominium.

DONOR - One who donates, typically, money.

CROON - To hum or sing softly or in a sentimental manner.

CONDOR - Either of two New World vultures, *Vultur gryphus* of the Andes or *Gymnogyps californianus*, a nearly extinct vulture of the mountains of California.

CORDON - A ribbon normally worn diagonally across the chest as a decoration or insignia of rank etc.

CONCORD - A state of agreement; harmony; union.
