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Word definitions - wordscapes level 3762

BAT - Any of the small, nocturnal, flying mammals of the order Chiroptera, which navigate by means of echolocation. They look like a mouse with membranous wings extending from the forelimbs to the hind limbs or tail. Altogether, there are about 1,000 bat species in the world.

BAY - A berry.

BIT - A piece of metal placed in a horse's mouth and connected to reins to direct the animal.

LAB - A laboratory.

LAY - To place down in a position of rest, or in a horizontal position.

LIT - Little.

TAB - A small flap or strip of material attached to something, for holding, manipulation, identification, etc.

TIL - Until, till.

AIL - Painful; troublesome.

BAIL - Security, usually a sum of money, exchanged for the release of an arrested person as a guarantee of that person's appearance for trial.

BAIT - Any substance, especially food, used in catching fish, or other animals, by alluring them to a hook, snare, trap, or net.

TAIL - The caudal appendage of an animal that is attached to its posterior and near the anus.

ABLY - In an able manner; with great ability.

ALIBI - The plea or mode of defense under which a person on trial for a crime proves or attempts to prove that he was in another place when the alleged act was committed; as, to set up an alibi; to prove an alibi.

LAITY - People of a church who are not ordained clergy or clerics.
