

Word definitions - wordscapes level 3770

ALL - Intensifier.

SAY - To pronounce.

SLY - Artfully cunning; secretly mischievous; wily.

ALLY - To unite, or form a connection between, as between families by marriage, or between princes and states by treaty, league, or confederacy.

LAST - Final, ultimate, coming after all others of its kind.

SALT - A common substance, chemically consisting mainly of sodium chloride (NaCl), used extensively as a condiment and preservative.

STAY - A strong rope supporting a mast, and leading from the head of one mast down to some other, or other part of the vessel.

TALL - Obsequious; obedient.

SLAT - A thin, narrow strip or bar of wood or metal.

SLAY - To eradicate or stamp out.

SALTY - Tasting of salt.

STALL - A compartment for a single animal in a stable or cattle shed.

TALLY - Used as a mild intensifier: very (almost exclusively used by the upper classes).

LASTLY - Used to mark the beginning of the last in a list of items or propositions.
