This puzzle 64 extra words make it fun to play.

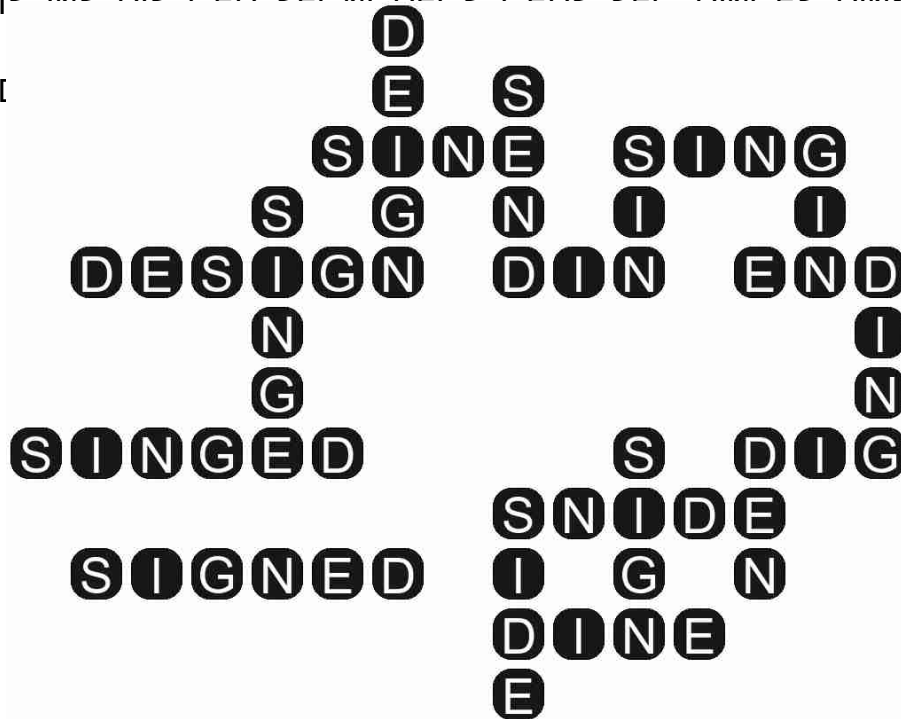
Reaching this point shows that you completed 43,905 words and 181,938 letters.

Word definitions - wordscapes level 3776

DEN - The home of certain animals.

DIG - To move hard-packed earth out of the way, especially downward to make a hole with a shovel. Or to drill, or the like, through rocks, roads, or the like. More generally, to make any similar hole by moving material out of the way.

END - The final point of something in space or time.

GIN - A colourless non-aged alcoholic liquor made by distilling fermented grains such as barley, corn, oats or rye with juniper berries; the base for many cocktails.

SIN - A violation of God's will or religious law.

DIN - A loud noise; a cacophony or loud commotion.

DINE - To eat; to eat dinner or supper.

DING - Very minor damage, a small dent or chip.

SEND - To make something (such as an object or message) go from one place to another.

SIDE - A bounding straight edge of a two-dimensional shape.

SIGN - A visible indication.

SING - To produce musical or harmonious sounds with one's voice.

SINE - In a right triangle, the ratio of the length of the side opposite an angle to the length of the hypotenuse.

SNIDE - Sharp.

DEIGN - To condescend; to accept as appropriate to one's dignity.

SINGE - To burn slightly.

DESIGN - A plan (with more or less detail) for the structure and functions of an artifact, building or system.
