This puzzle 45 extra words make it fun to play.

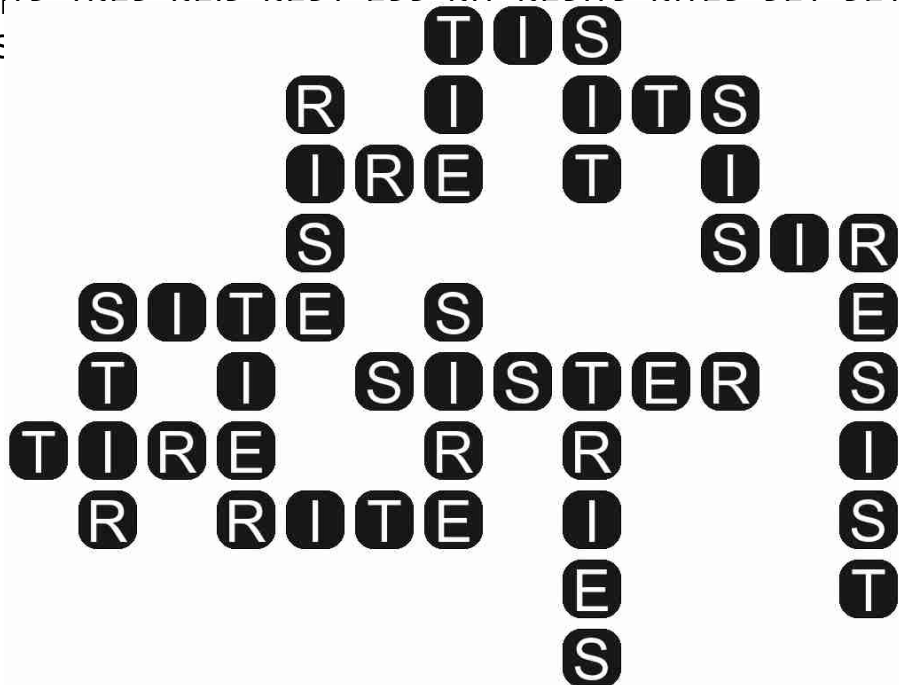
