This puzzle 38 extra words make it fun to play.

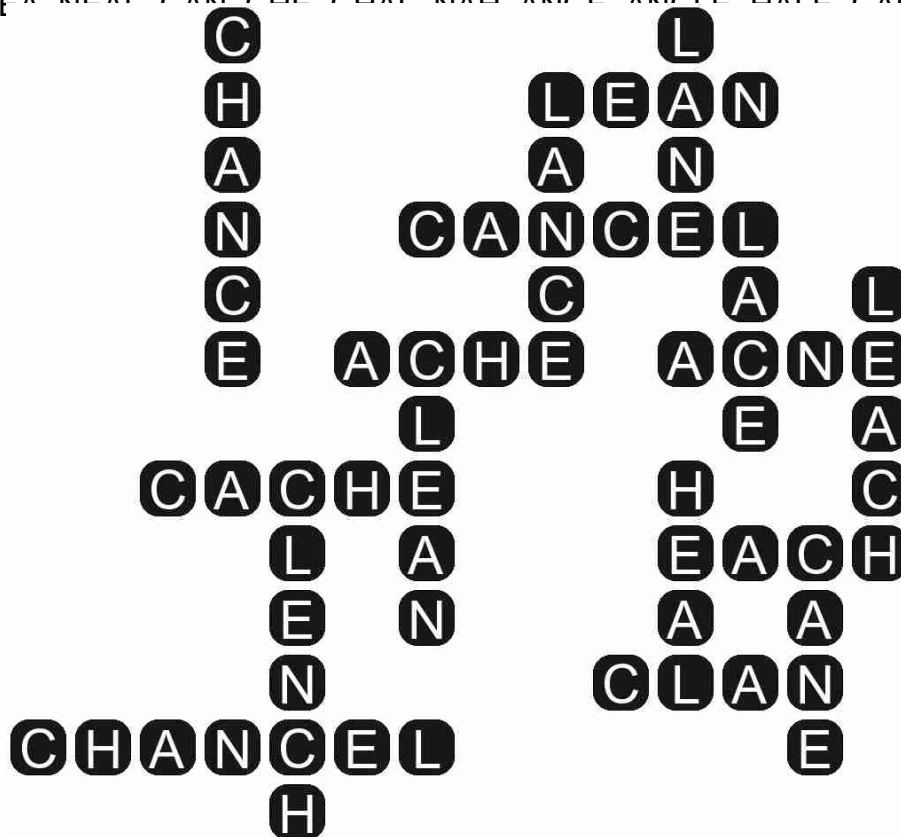
Reaching this point shows that you completed 43,998 words and 182,326 letters.

# Word definitions - wordscapes level 3784

ACNE - A skin condition, usually of the face, that is common in adolescents. It is characterized by red pimples, and is caused by the inflammation of sebaceous glands through bacterial infection.

CANE - The slender, flexible main stem of a plant such as bamboo, including many species in the Grass family Gramineae.

CLAN - A group of people all descended from a common ancestor, in fact or belief.

EACH - All; every; qualifying a singular noun, indicating all examples of the thing so named seen as individual or separate items (compare every).

HEAL - To hide; conceal; keep secret.

LACE - A light fabric containing patterns of holes, usually built up from a single thread.

LANE - A narrow passageway between fences, walls, hedges or trees.

LEAN - To hang outwards.

ACHE - To suffer pain; to be the source of, or be in, pain, especially continued dull pain; to be distressed.

CLEAN - Not dirty.

LANCE - A weapon of war, consisting of a long shaft or handle and a steel blade or head; a spear carried by horsemen.

CACHE - A store of things that may be required in the future, which can be retrieved rapidly, protected or hidden in some way.

LEACH - A quantity of wood ashes, through which water passes, and thus imbibes the alkali.

CANCEL - To cross out something with lines etc.

CHANCE - An opportunity or possibility.

CLENCH - Tight grip.

# Word definitions - wordscapes level 3784

CHANCEL - The space around the altar in a church, often enclosed, for use by the clergy and the choir. In medieval cathedrals the chancel was usually enclosed or blocked off from the nave by an altar screen.
