This puzzle 49 extra words make it fun to play.

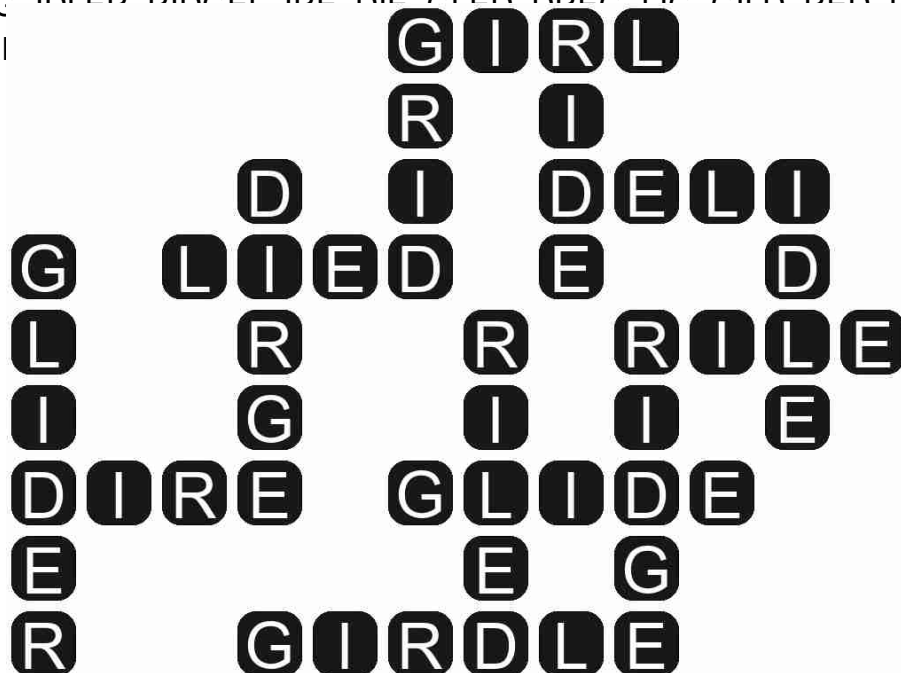
Reaching this point shows that you completed 44,089 words and 182,727 letters.

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 3792

DIRE - Ill-boding; portentous.

GIRL - A young female human; (in contrast to boy), a female child or young adult.

GRID - A rectangular array of squares or rectangles of equal size, such as in a cross word puzzle.

LIED - An art song, sung in German and accompanied on the piano.

RIDE - To play defense on the defensemen or midfielders, as an attackman.

DELI - A shop that sells cooked or prepared food ready for serving.

IDLE - Empty, vacant.

RILE - To make angry.

GLIDE - To move softly, smoothly, or effortlessly.

RIDGE - The back of any animal; especially the upper or projecting part of the back of a quadruped.

DIRGE - A mournful poem or piece of music composed or performed as a memorial to a dead person.

RILED - Simple past tense and past participle of rile.

GIRDLE - That which girds, encircles, or encloses; a circumference.

GLIDER - Any heavier-than-air aircraft optimised for unpowered flight; a sailplane.
