This puzzle 40 extra words make it fun to play.


Reaching this point shows that you completed 44,623 words and 184,864 letters.

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# Word definitions - wordscapes level 3834

AIM - The pointing of a weapon, as a gun, a dart, or an arrow, or object, in the line of direction with the object intended to be struck; the line of fire; the direction of anything, as a spear, a blow, a discourse, a remark, towards a particular point or object, with a view to strike or affect it.

ARM - The portion of the upper human appendage, from the shoulder to the wrist and so metimes including the hand.

MAR - To spoil, to damage.

RAM - A male sheep.

RIM - An edge around something, especially when circular.

MIL - An angular mil, a unit of angular measurement equal to  $1/6400$  of a complete circle. At 1000 metres one mil subtends about one metre (0.98 m). Also  $1/6000$  and  $1/6300$  are used in other countries.

AIL - Painful; troublesome.

LAM - Used in the expression on the lam to mean that a person is fleeing law enforcement, possibly in hiding.

LIAR - One who tells lies.

MAIL - To send (a letter or parcel) through the mail.

RAIL - A horizontal bar extending between supports and used for support or as a barrier; a railing.

LAIR - A place inhabited by a wild animal, often a cave or a hole in the ground.

ALARM - A summons to arms, as on the approach of an enemy.

MALARIA - A disease spread by mosquito, in which a protozoan, Plasmodium, multiplies in blood every few days.
