This puzzle 17 extra words make it cool to play.


Reaching this point shows that you completed 45,028 words and 186,547 letters.

Word definitions - wordscapes level 3868

ELF - A mythical, supernatural being resembling but seen as distinct from humans.

FIT - Suitable, proper.

ILL - Extremely bad (bad enough to make one ill). Generally used indirectly with to be.

LIE - To be in a horizontal position.

FELL - To make something fall; especially to chop down a tree.

FELT - A cloth or stuff made of matted fibres of wool, or wool and fur, fullered or wrought into a compact substance by rolling and pressure, with leers or size, without spinning or weaving.

FILE - A collection of papers collated and archived together.

FILL - To occupy fully, to take up all of.

LEFT - The opposite of right; toward the west when one is facing north.

LIFE - The state that follows birth, and precedes death; the state of being alive and living.

LIFT - Air.

TELL - To count, reckon, or enumerate.

TILE - A regularly-shaped slab of clay or other material, affixed to cover or decorate a surface, as in a roof-tile, glazed tile, stove tile, etc.

TILL - To.

LILT - To do something rhythmically, with animation and quickness, usually of music.

LITE - Light in composition, notably low in fat, calories etc.:

FLIT - A fluttering or darting movement.
