This puzzle 50 extra words make it fun to play.

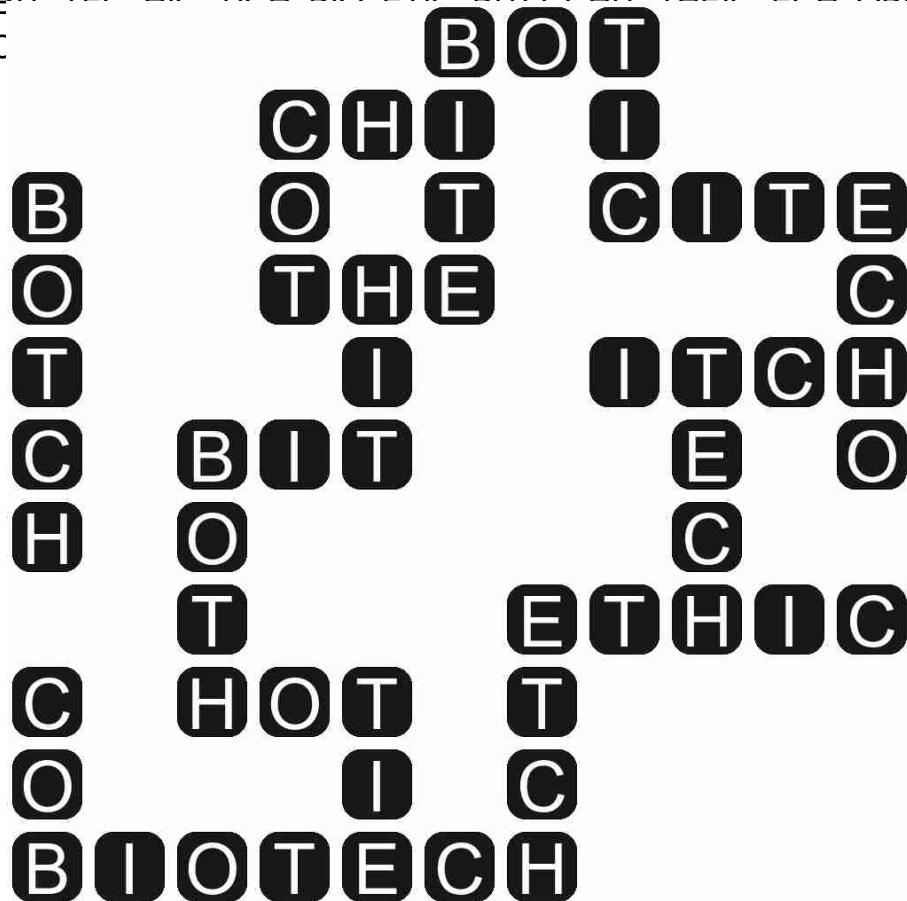
Reaching this point shows that you completed 46,946 words and 194,439 letters.

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 4032

BIT - A piece of metal placed in a horse's mouth and connected to reins to direct the animal.

HIT - To administer a blow to.

HOT - Of an object, having a high temperature.

THE - With a comparative or more and a verb phrase, establishes a parallel with one or more other such comparatives.

TIE - A necktie (item of clothing consisting of a strip of cloth tied around the neck).

CHI - The twenty-second letter of the Classical and Modern Greek alphabets, and the twenty-third letter of Old and Ancient alphabets.

COT - A symbol of the trigonometric function cotangent.

BOT - The larva of a bot fly, which infests the skin of various mammals, producing warbles, or the nasal passage of sheep, or the stomach of horses.

COB - A male swan.

TIC - A local and habitual convulsive motion of certain muscles.

BITE - To cut off a piece by clamping the teeth.

BOTH - Each of the two; one and the other.

CITE - To quote; to repeat, as a passage from a book, or the words of another.

ECHO - A reflected sound that is heard again by its initial observer.

ITCH - A sensation felt on an area of the skin that causes a person or animal to want to scratch.

TECH - Technology.

ETCH - To cut into a surface with an acid or other corrosive substance in order to make a pattern. Best known as a technique for creating printing plates, but also used for
