Word definitions - wordscapes level 4288

ARM - The portion of the upper human appendage, from the shoulder to the wrist and so metimes including the hand.

MAN - An adult male human.

MAR - To spoil, to damage.

NOR - Used to introduce a further negative statement.

OAR - An implement used to propel a boat or a ship in the water, having a flat blade at one end, being rowed from the other end and being normally fastened to the vessel.

RAM - A male sheep.

RAN - Simple past of run.

LAM - Used in the expression on the lam to mean that a person is fleeing law enforcement, possibly in hiding.

LOAN - A sum of money or other valuables or consideration that an individual, group or other legal entity borrows from another individual, group or legal entity (the latter often being a financial institution) with the condition that it be returned or repaid at a later date (sometimes with interest).

ORAL - A physical examination of the mouth.

ROAM - To wander or travel freely and with no specific destination.

NORM - That which is regarded as normal or typical.

MOAN - A low, mournful cry of pain, sorrow or pleasure.

LOAM - A kind of soil; an earthy mixture of clay and sand, with organic matter to which its fertility is chiefly due.

ROAN - Especially of a horse, having a coat of a dark base color with individual white hairs mixed in.

MORAL - Of or relating to principles of right and wrong in behaviour, especially for
