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Word definitions - wordscapes level 4290

ACE - A single point or spot on a playing card or die.

HAD - Simple past tense and past participle of have.

CAD - A person who stands at the door of an omnibus to open and shut it, and to receive fares; an idle hanger-on about innyards.

CAKE - A rich, sweet dessert food, typically made of flour, sugar, and eggs and baked in an oven, and often covered in icing.

DECK - Any flat surface that can be walked on: a balcony; a porch; a raised patio; a flat rooftop.

EACH - All; every; qualifying a singular noun, indicating all examples of the things or named seen as individual or separate items (compare every).

HACK - To hack into; to gain unauthorized access to (a computer system, e.g., a website, or network) by manipulating code; to crack.

HEAD - The part of the body of an animal or human which contains the brain, mouth, and main sense organs.

ACHE - To suffer pain; to be the source of, or be in, pain, especially continued dull pain; to be distressed.

ACED - Simple past tense and past participle of ace.

CHAD - Small pieces of paper punched out from the edges of continuous stationery, punched cards, paper tape etc.

ACHED - Simple past tense and past participle of ache.

CAKED - Simple past tense and past participle of cake.

HACKED - Simple past tense and past participle of hack.
