BID - To issue a command; to tell.

DRY - Free from liquid or moisture.

HID - Simple past of hide.

RIB - Any of a series of long curved bones occurring in 12 pairs in humans and other animals and extending from the spine to or toward the sternum.

RID - Released from an obligation, problem, etc. (usually followed by "of").

BIRD - A member of the class of animals Aves in the phylum Chordata, characterized by being warm-blooded, having feathers and wings usually capable of flight, and laying eggs.

BIRDY - Excited due to having encountered a bird or its scent.

HYBRID - Offspring resulting from cross-breeding different entities, e.g. two different species or two purebred parent strains.
