

Word definitions - wordscapes level 4432

DUEL - Arranged, regular combat between two private persons, often over a matter of honor.

DUES - Plural form of due.

DULL - Lacking the ability to cut easily; not sharp.

DUST - Fine, dry particles of matter found in the air and covering the surface of objects, typically consisting of soil lifted up by the wind, pollen, hair, etc.

LETS - Plural form of let.

LUST - To very strongly desire.

SELL - To agree to transfer goods or provide services in exchange for money.

SLED - A small, light vehicle with runners, used, mostly by young persons, for sliding on snow or ice. (A "sled" in this sense is not pulled by an animal as a "sleigh" is .).

STUD - A male animal, especially a stud horse (stallion), kept for breeding.

TELL - To count, reckon, or enumerate.

USED - Simple past tense and past participle of use.

LEST - For fear that; that . . . not; in order that . . . not; in case.

SUED - Simple past tense and past participle of sue.

DUET - A musical composition in two parts, each performed by a single voice (singer, instrument or univoce ensemble).

LUTE - A fretted stringed instrument, similar to a guitar, having a bowl-shaped body or soundbox.

DELL - Valley.

LUSTED - Undefined

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
