EVE - The day or night before, usually used for holidays, such as Christmas Eve.

SEE - To perceive or detect with the eyes, or as if by sight.

SIR - A man of a higher rank or position.

VIE - To rival; to struggle for superiority; to contend; to compete eagerly so as to gain something.

EVER - Always.

RICE - Cereal plants (*Oryza sativa*) of the grass family whose seeds are used as food.

RISE - The process of or an action or instance of moving upwards or becoming greater.

VICE - A bad habit.

SEER - Agent noun of see; one who sees something; an eyewitness.

SIRE - A lord, master, or other person in authority, most commonly used vocatively.

VEER - A turn or swerve; an instance of veering.

WISE - An instrument consisting of two jaws, closing by a screw, lever, cam, or the like, for holding work, as in filing.

CRIES - Third-person singular simple present indicative form of cry.

SERVE - An act of putting the ball or shuttlecock in play in various games.

VERSE - A poetic form with regular meter and a fixed rhyme scheme.

SEVER - To cut free.

SIEVE - A device to separate larger objects from smaller objects, or to separate solid objects from a liquid.

SCREE - Loose stony debris on a slope.
