

Word definitions - wordscapes level 4484

AIR - The atmospheric substance above the surface of the earth which animals breathe, formerly considered to be a single substance, one of the four basic elements of ancient philosophy and one of the five basic elements of Eastern traditions.

ANY - To even the slightest extent, at all.

GIN - A colourless non-aged alcoholic liquor made by distilling fermented grains such as barley, corn, oats or rye with juniper berries; the base for many cocktails.

NAG - A small horse; a pony.

RAG - A coarse kind of rock, somewhat cellular in texture; ragstone.

RAY - A beam of light or radiation.

RIG - The rigging of a sailing ship or other such craft.

GAIN - Against.

GRIN - A smile in which the lips are parted to reveal the teeth.

RAIN - Condensed water falling from a cloud.

RANG - Simple past of ring.

RING - A circumscribing object, (roughly) circular and hollow, looking like an annual ring, earring, finger ring etc.

YARN - A twisted strand of fiber used for knitting or weaving.

AIRY - Consisting of air; as, an airy substance; the airy parts of bodies.

NARY - Not one.

ANGRY - Displaying or feeling anger.

GRAIN - The harvested seeds of various grass-related food crops eg: wheat, corn, barley.

RAINY - Abounding with rain; wet; showery; as, rainy weather; a rainy day or season.

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RANGY - Slender and long of limb; lanky.

GRAINY - Resembling grains; granular.
