This puzzle 29 extra words make it fun to play.

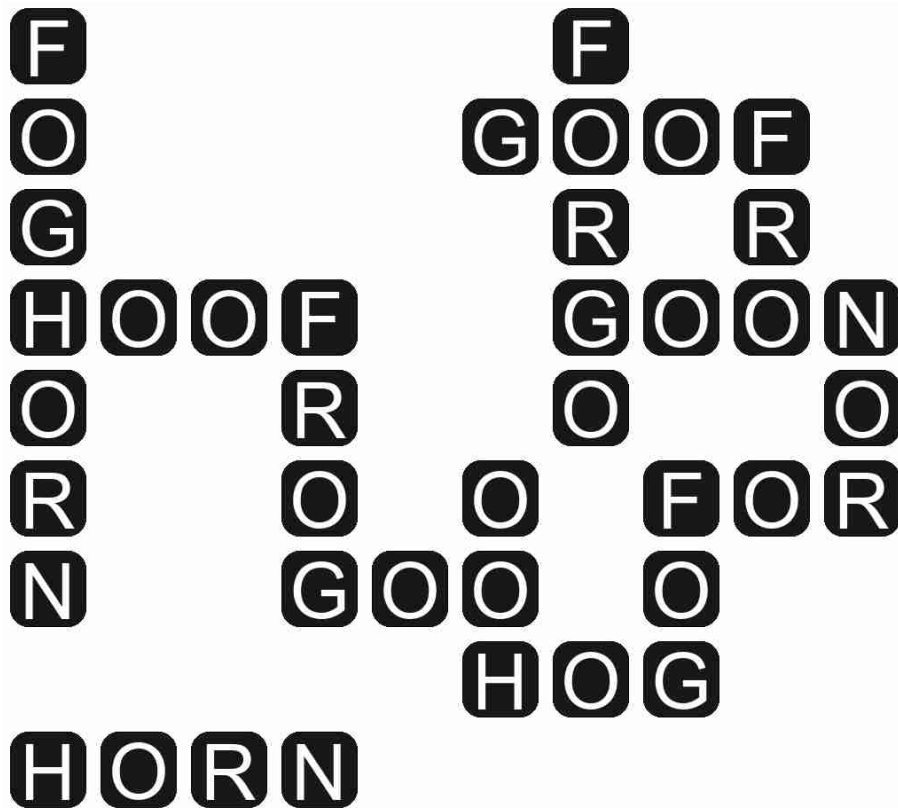
Reaching this point shows that you completed 52,446 words and 216,483 letters.

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Word definitions - wordscapes level 4488

FOG - A thick cloud that forms near the ground; the obscurity of such a cloud.

FOR - Because.

HOG - Any animal belonging to the Suidae family of mammals, especially the pig, the w
art hog, and the boar.

NOR - Used to introduce a further negative statement.

OOH - An expression of surprise.

FRO - From; away; back or backward. In modern English used only in the set phrase to
and fro ("back and forth").

GOO - Any semi-solid or liquid substance; especially one that is sticky, gummy or sli
ppery; frequently of vague or unknown composition, or a bodily fluid.

FROG - A small tailless amphibian of the order Anura that typically hops.

HORN - A hard growth of keratin that protrudes from the top of the head of certain an
imals.

GOOF - A mistake or error.

GOON - A thug; a usually muscular henchman with little intelligence (also known as a
'hired goon').

HOOF - The tip of a toe of an ungulate such as a horse, ox or deer, strengthened by a
thick keratin covering.

FORGO - To let pass, to leave alone.

FOGHORN - A very loud low-pitched horn, used especially in lighthouses and on large b
oats.
