This puzzle 38 extra words make it fun to play.

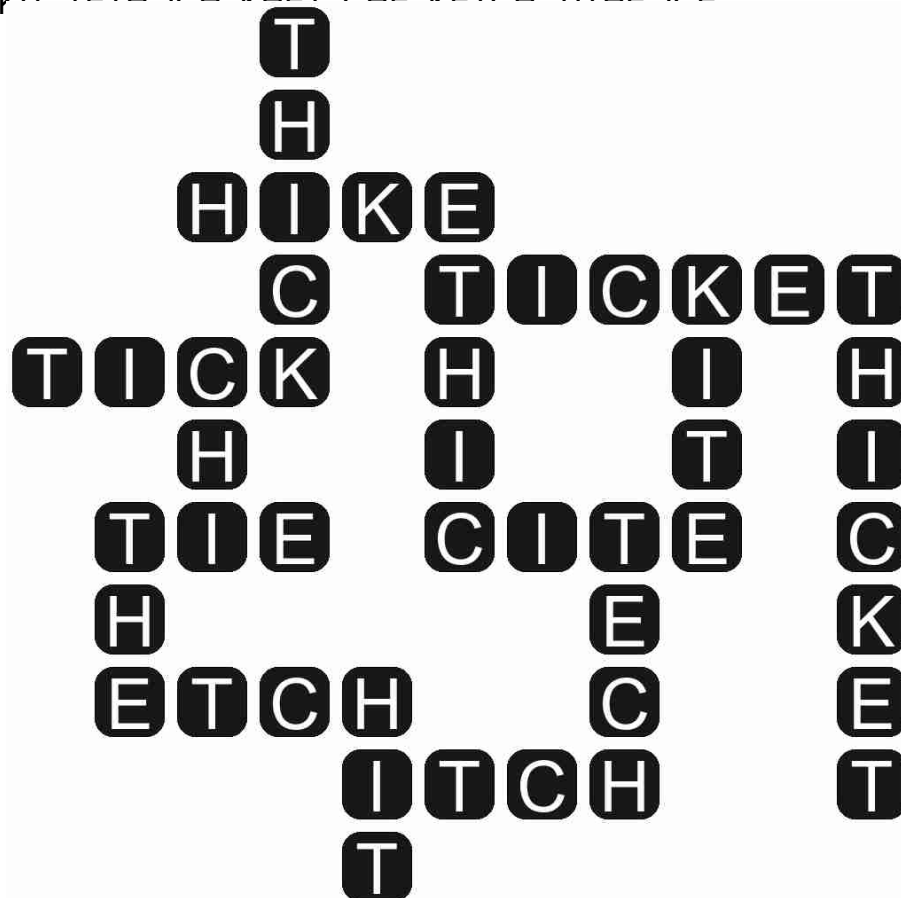
Reaching this point shows that you completed 52,471 words and 216,577 letters.

# Word definitions - wordscapes level 4490

HIT - To administer a blow to.

THE - With a comparative or more and a verb phrase, establishes a parallel with one or more other such comparatives.

TIE - A necktie (item of clothing consisting of a strip of cloth tied around the neck).

CHI - The twenty-second letter of the Classical and Modern Greek alphabets, and the twenty-third letter of Old and Ancient alphabets.

CITE - To quote; to repeat, as a passage from a book, or the words of another.

HIKE - A long walk.

ITCH - A sensation felt on an area of the skin that causes a person or animal to want to scratch.

TECH - Technology.

TICK - A tiny woodland arthropod of the order Acarina.

ETCH - To cut into a surface with an acid or other corrosive substance in order to make a pattern. Best known as a technique for creating printing plates, but also used for decoration on metal, and, in modern industry, to make circuit boards.

ETHIC - Moral, relating to morals.

THICK - Relatively great in extent from one surface to the opposite in its smallest solid dimension.

TICKET - A pass entitling the holder to admission to a show, concert, etc.

THICKET - A dense, but generally small, growth of shrubs, bushes or small trees; a copse.

KITE - Any of falconiform birds of prey in the subfamily Elaninae of the family Accipitridae with long wings and weak legs, feeding mostly on carrion and spending long periods soaring.
